## FOUR WAYS TO PAY YOUR BILL:

### 1. Auto-Pay:

Automatically deducted from your bank account and never miss a payment again. Call our office at **480-837-9444** or go to our website to enroll.

### 2. Online Bill Payment:

Securely pay your bill online with a credit/debit card (a separate convenience fee of 1.5% applies) or an E-Check (a separate \$1.00 fee applies) at [www.az-fhsd.gov](http://www.az-fhsd.gov).

### 3. Mail Payment:

Please include the top portion of your billing statement. Make check payable to: **Fountain Hills Sanitary District** or **FHSD** and mail to 16941 E. Pepperwood Circle, Fountain Hills, AZ 85268

### 4. Pay in Person:

Deliver your payment to our Billing Department located at 16941 E. Pepperwood Circle, Fountain Hills, **Monday-Thursday 7:00 AM-4:00 PM** and **Friday 7:00 AM-1:00 PM**.

## LATE FEE:

The Sanitary District gives residents an ample amount of time to pay their sewer user fee before a \$25.00 late fee is applied. To maintain your good payment history and avoid the late fee, make your payment by the due date listed on the front side of this bill. Payments not received in full by the due date may result in additional interest or lien fees. ## Ramada/Well Project at Fountain Park Nears Completion

Construction is in the home stretch for the new ramada and well control building at Fountain Park. The project started in April and is on target to be completed sometime in November 2024. A sizable portion of this new structure will serve park visitors as a shade ramada and viewpoint, while the other portion will house the control components for an Aquifer Storage and Recovery (ASR) well.

When construction is complete, the Fount Rushmore statues will be relocated in a better arrangement for visitors to experience. The existing sidewalk will be relocated for better access to the ramada and view point of the Fountain.

The Sanitary District owns and operates five ASR Wells as the means to store and recover excess recycled water, with three of these wells located in Fountain Park. Currently, the wells store up to 300 million gallons of highly treated recycled water in the winter to be recovered and used for irrigation in the summer at local parks and golf courses.

### Fountain Hills Sanitary Facts:

The Wastewater Treatment Facility is designed to handle wash water and the 3P's: pee, poop and (toilet) paper.

### The Truth about Clogs:

Flushing down the toilet anything other than the 3P's such as personal wipes, paper towels, cotton swabs, floss, etc... causes clogs in sewer lines.

### Do not flush "Flushables"

#### wipes:

Flushable wipes do not breakdown like toilet paper does.

## National Prescription Drug Take Back Day

Dispose of unused or unwanted prescription pills on Saturday, October 26, 2024, at the Town Hall main entrance between the hours of 10:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m. This includes pets prescription too! Please, no liquids, creams, or needles. Pour unused pills into a clear plastic bag.

If you miss this event, the Maricopa County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) has a drop box located in the lobby of Town Hall to dispose of unused or unwanted prescription pills. This drop box is accessible during regular business hours. Properly disposing of unwanted prescription pills prevents misuse and helps protect the environment.
